DORRINGTON ROAD INTERSECTION “ON THE AGENDA”

Greg Piper, Member for Lake Macquarie, has on a number of occasions told Minister for Roads, Eric Roozendaal, how important it is to fix this intersection. Mr Piper met yesterday with the Minister's staff to discuss the problem and possible solutions. Greg anticipates that the Minister's office will soon be able to suggest one or more options to the RTA for improvements to the intersection.

"I have raised the problem with the Minister for Road's staff and made the point that, for whatever reason, accident statistics show there is a problem." Mr Piper said.

"They now know there is a problem and that the community want it addressed. I'm hopeful that efforts will be made to find a solution and I'm sure that the local community aren't about to give up on having improvements carried out."

"The fact is that this intersection is dangerous and the RTA should make improving the safety here a priority."

Mr Piper delivered a speech in Parliament on Wednesday 3 November in which he described the problem and the urgent need for a solution.
